Job Description:

Teaching at MKC is a unique opportunity for experienced paddlers to work in a professional, intimate and incredibly rewarding environment. We seek confident instructors – capable of teaching in Class II-IV – in either solo canoe, tandem canoe or kayak. Just as important, instructors must have strong interpersonal skills, be able to work in small groups, and act as an effective leader to paddlers of all ages.

Responsibilities:

- Perform, analyze and correct whitewater canoeing or kayaking skills on the water and using video analysis
- Teach to a variety of learning styles, abilities and personalities
- Facilitate learning of river rescue, scouting and self-rescue techniques
- Attend Instructor meetings with the Head Instructor daily, to plan the days agenda or re-cap the day
- Fine-tune classes to the needs of the group (classes are small to allow time with individual students)
- Organize course content, and shuttles with a risk management action plan
- Provide some evening programming
- Preparation for river trips (for 5 Day Programs)
- Work collaboratively with other teams at MKC, performing duties to help with upkeep of our facilities

Job Requirements:

- Minimum two seasons of whitewater canoeing or kayaking
- Must have track record of guiding / instructing guests in moving water
- Swift water Rescue Certificate
- First Aid and CPR Certificate
- Paddle Canada Moving Water Instructor Certification
- A valid F Class driver's license is an asset (compensated with a higher wage)
